The *Alberta Law Review* is soliciting contributions for its upcoming special issue on “Insurance Law.” Submissions covering any aspect of this area of the law are welcome. In particular, submissions may address any insurance law matter, whether applicable to insurance law in general or to a particular class of insurance law (for example: life insurance, disability insurance, property insurance, or automobile insurance); focus on any source of insurance law (for example: common law, statute, or equity) from any jurisdiction having relevance to the development of Canadian law; and draw from any perspective (for example: social policy, legal theory, or practice). The intention is that the submissions in this special issue will collectively offer detailed and thoughtful analysis of a variety of insurance law issues which may be of relevance to scholars, practitioners, judges, legislators, and policy makers.

Articles, case/legislation comments and notes, book reviews, or other manuscripts will be considered for review. Manuscripts must conform to the *Canadian Guide to Uniform Legal Citation*, 7th ed. (Toronto: Carswell, 2010). Submissions made exclusively to the *Alberta Law Review* will be given priority in the review process. The editors request that articles be less than 60 double-spaced pages. Case comments may be 10-30 double-spaced pages long, and book reviews may be 4-8 double-spaced pages long. Manuscripts will not be returned.

To be considered for this special issue, manuscripts should be submitted on or before August 31, 2012. Manuscripts can be submitted electronically with an additional copy to follow by mail. Please direct all correspondence to the following address:
